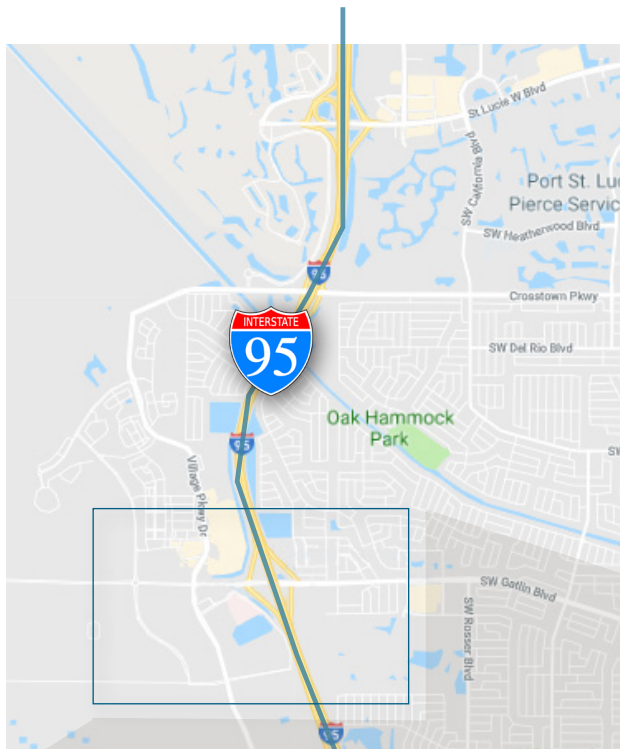

- Phase III: 1 2-story Office Building totaling 32,000 +/- gsf

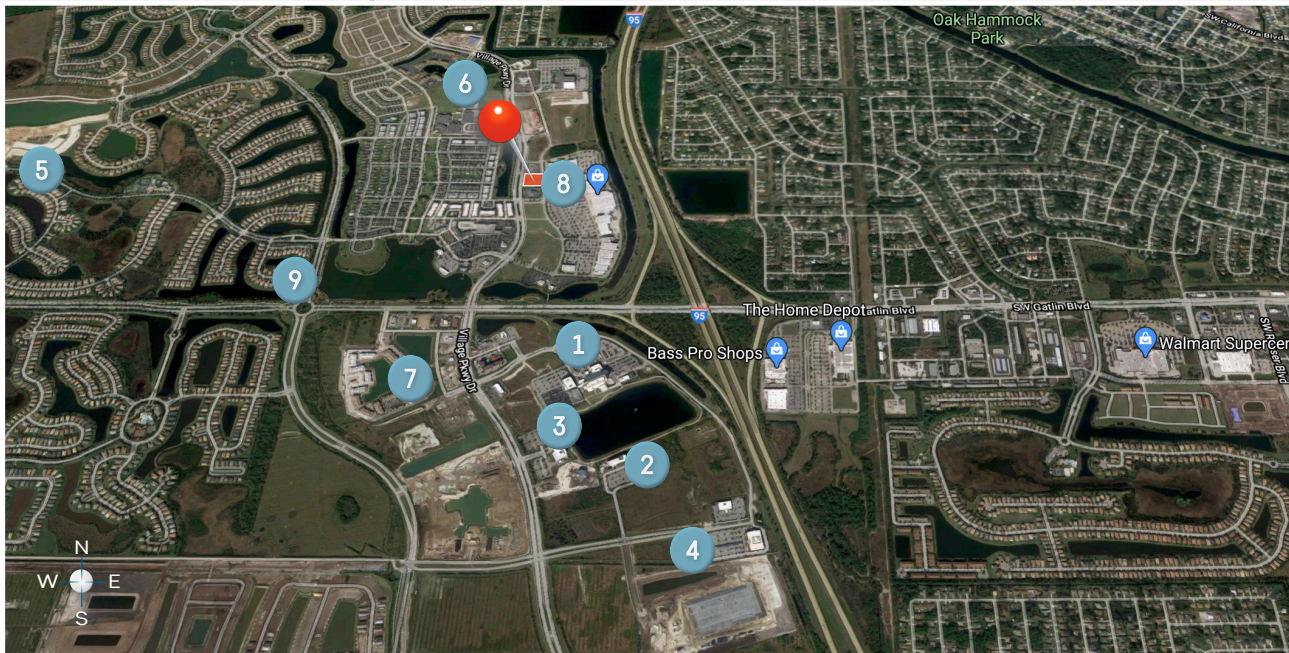
LOCATION

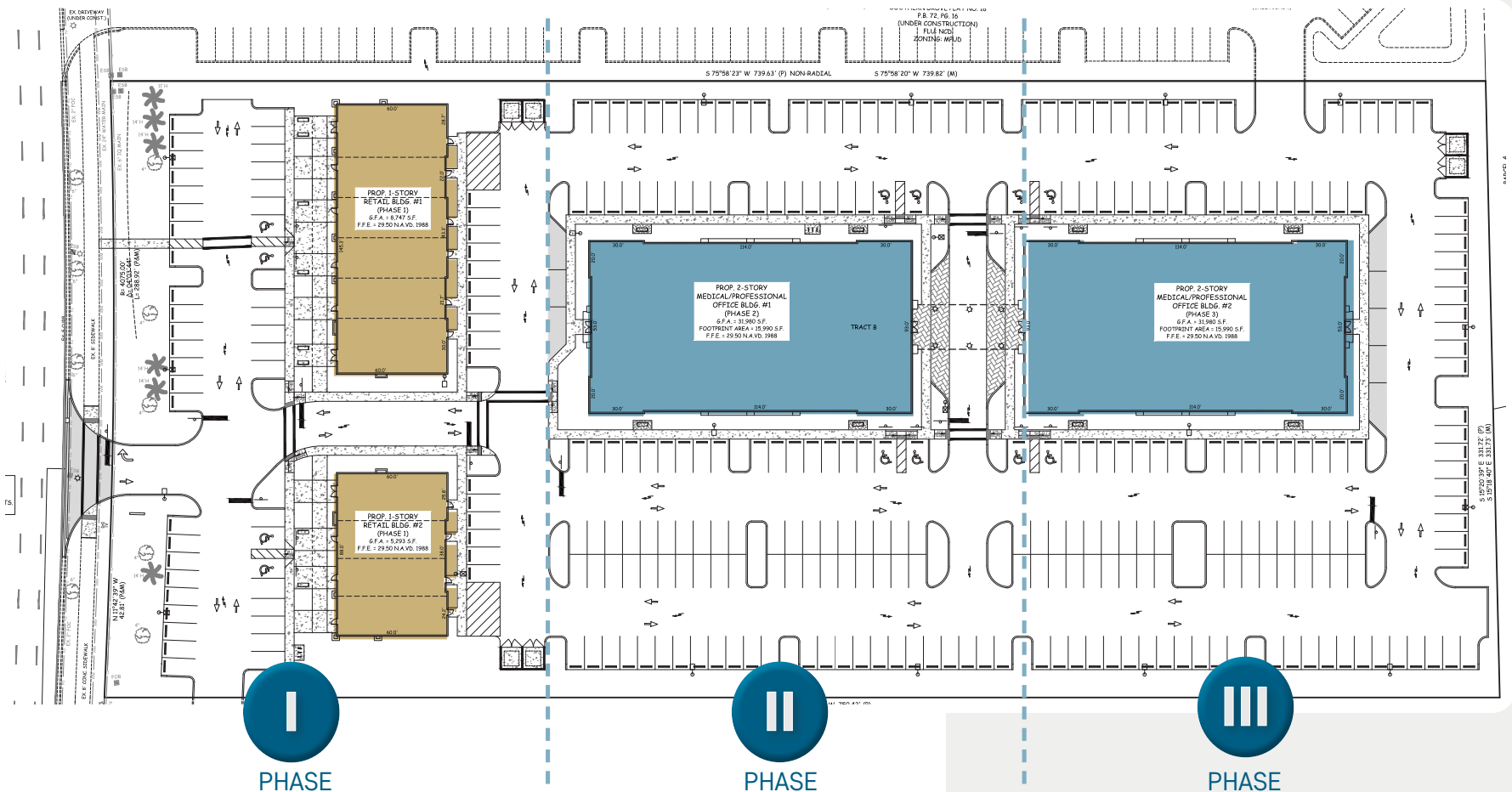

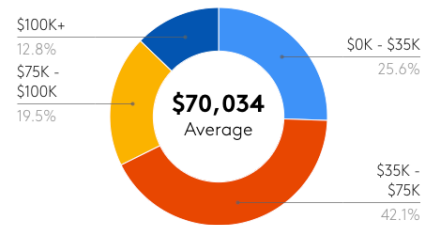

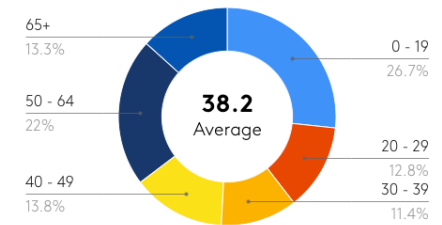


TRADITION DEMOGRAPHICS
